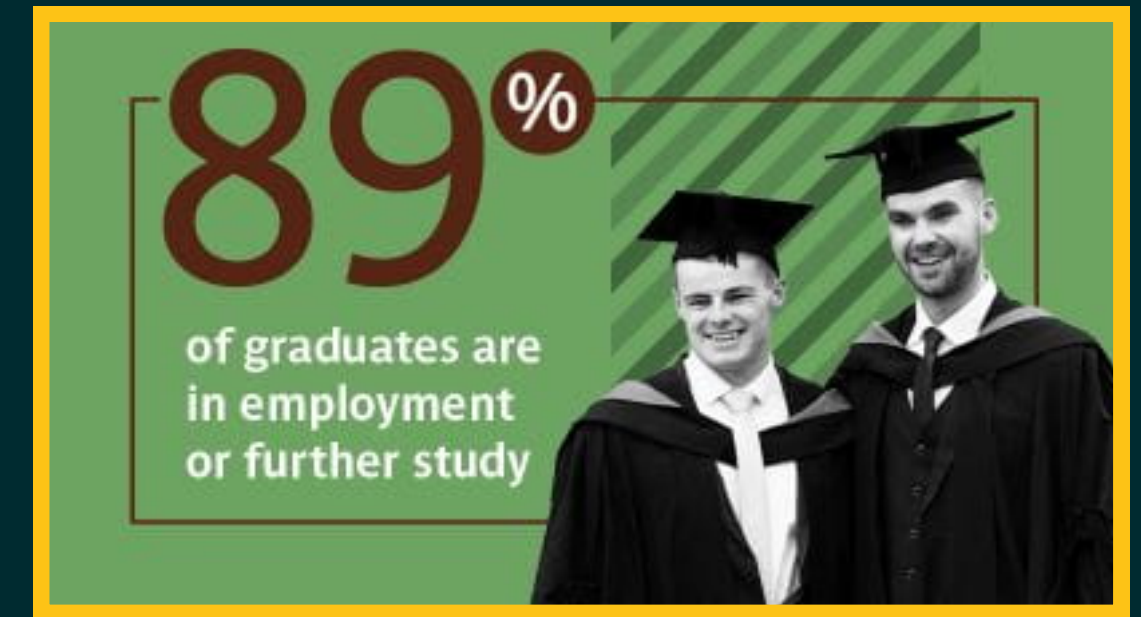

**The UWE Bristol MSc Project Management (online)** is a two-year, part-time programme built to integrate with your professional commitments. Combining structured theory and project management frameworks, with practical case studies and applied learning, it equips you to manage complex projects with confidence and clarity across a range of industries and contexts.

## Core Modules: Building your project management toolkit

Each builds on the next to give you a structured and comprehensive learning experience, covering methodologies, leadership, risk, finance, and stakeholder management.

## Apply your knowledge: Your final project

In your final year, you'll complete a 30-credit project challenge module. You'll choose a real-world problem related to your professional interests and apply your learning in a high-impact investigation.

# CORE MODULES

Discover core modules that build your skills in planning, leading and delivering successful projects. You'll cover the full project lifecycle – from selecting the right methodology to managing complexity, risk and closure. Each module will be 15 credits, with the final project being 30 credits.



## Project Management Life Cycle and Processes

15 credits

Gain a clear understanding of each stage of the project life cycle, from initiation through to closure. Define scope, set objectives, engage stakeholders and apply scheduling methods. Build a solid foundation needed for effective project delivery.



## Project Management Methodologies

15 credits

Compare and evaluate the main project methodologies used in industry, including traditional, agile and hybrid approaches. Learn how to select and apply the most effective method for different project types using real-world case studies.



## Project Management Dynamics

15 credits

Explore how organisational culture, behaviour and leadership influence project outcomes. Understand how projects evolve in complex settings and develop the skills to manage collaboration, motivation and change in dynamic environments.



## Leadership in Project Environments

15 credits

Strengthen your leadership capabilities with practical tools and models tailored to project settings. Explore emotional intelligence, conflict resolution and motivation, while developing your leadership style for diverse and evolving teams.



# CORE MODULES

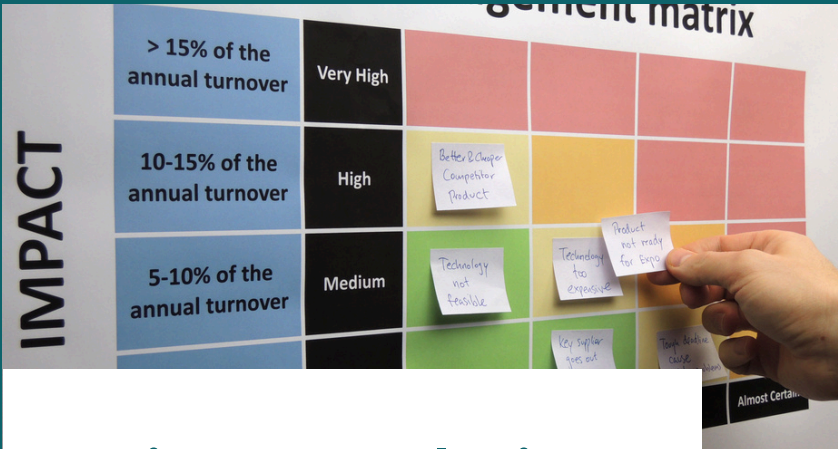
The programme has a total of 180 credits. You take ten core modules; each is worth 15 credits and is an average of eight weeks in duration. The journey culminates with your final research project worth 30 credits.



## Project Management in Context

15 credits

Place your project management knowledge within broader organisational, social and ethical frameworks. Understand how regulation, sustainability, and external forces impact project design and delivery.



## Project Complexity and Risk Management

15 credits

Develop strategies to manage complexity and risk in high-stakes projects. Learn to identify, assess and respond to potential challenges using tools such as systems thinking and stakeholder analysis.



## Project Professional Practice

15 credits

Enhance your professional identity and project management practice. Reflect on your career goals, examine ethical issues, and build confidence through practical activities aligned with real-world challenges.



## International Project Management

15 credits

Build a global perspective on managing projects across borders. Explore the challenges of working with international teams, global supply chains and diverse regulations to prepare for leadership in multinational settings.



# CORE MODULES AND FINAL PROJECT



## Project Transition and Closure

15 credits

Learn how to close projects effectively, from handover and knowledge capture to benefits realisation. This module focuses on strategies for closing contracts, sustaining stakeholder engagement and measuring success.



## Project Finance

15 credits

Master the financial side of project management. Gain key skills in budgeting, forecasting, cost control and value management, and learn how to make informed financial decisions that support project goals.



## The Project Challenge

30 credits

This final project brings together everything you've learned. You'll design, lead and deliver a substantial research-based project focused on a real-world issue in project management. The topic will be relevant to your interests or professional context, giving you the chance to investigate a current challenge, propose solutions, and apply strategic thinking in a practical setting.

The outcome will be a professionally presented report that shows you can deliver insight, value and impact through project work. The Project Challenge is your opportunity to apply theory to practice and prove your readiness to lead projects at the highest level.

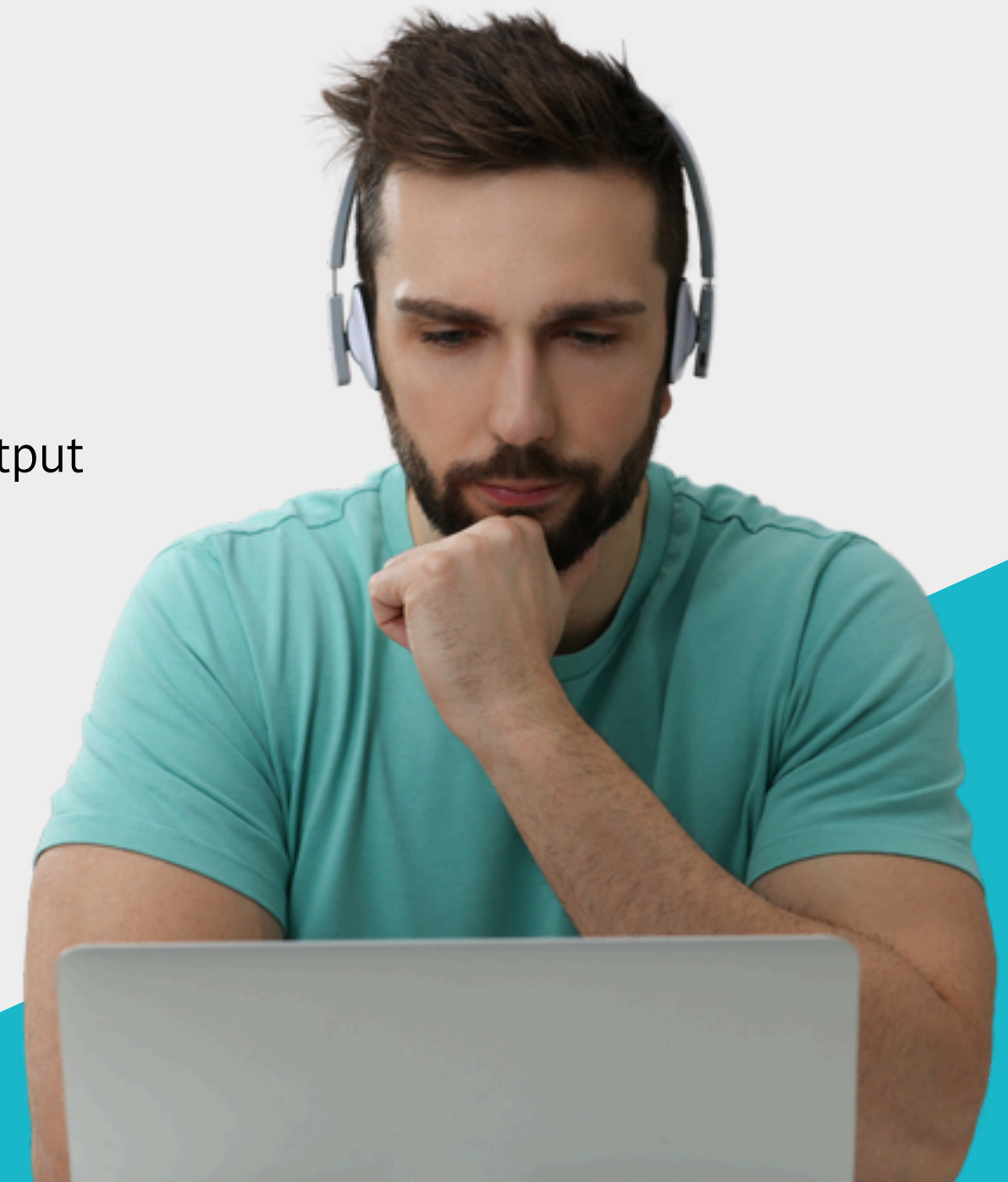

# Assessment methods

The MSc Project Management (online) programme utilises a variety of assessment techniques to evaluate your comprehension and practical application of course material. These include:

- **Written assignments** – Apply theory to practice through reports and reflective essays
- **Presentations** – Sharpen your ability to communicate project decisions with clarity
- **Group tasks** – Build collaboration and leadership skills through online teamwork
- **Simulations and case studies** – Practise applying frameworks to complex problems
- **Capstone project** – Conduct independent research and create a solution-focused project output



# Tuition fees

The fee for this programme is £7,950. You pay £795 per module.

Fees are paid on a modular basis over the duration of the two-year course. The balance for the current module needs to be paid before being able to register for the next module. For your convenience, invoices will be issued as near as possible to the start of each module. UK students pay by credit or debit and international students through our official online payment partner, Flywire.

## Scholarships and financial aid

UK (home) students may be eligible for UK postgraduate student loan assistance. Students who receive this funding need to complete the course within two years, otherwise payments will be interrupted or stopped. Find out more about postgraduate funding.

# Entry requirements

To be considered for the MSc Project Management (online) programme, you should have **a minimum of a 2:2 Honours degree** or equivalent.

If you do not meet the above requirements but have **a minimum of 12-months relevant professional experience** and/or equivalent qualifications, we recommend that you apply. All applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

## English language requirement

If English is not your first language, you'll be required to meet the University's minimum English language requirements, such as the International English Language Test (IELTS) with an overall score of 6.5 with 5.5 in each component.

\*The university accepts a large number of UK and International qualifications in place of IELTS. To find details of acceptable tests and the required grades, please visit our [English Language Requirements](#) pages.

## Exemption from the English language requirement

A Proof of English Language Proficiency (POE) exemption may be offered to you if you meet one of the following criteria:

- Completed at least three years of high school in an English-speaking country
- Completed an International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma in English
- Completed an IB diploma in a different language if they obtained a grade of 5 or higher for one of the English courses
- Completed a higher educational or professional qualification in English
- Working in an English-speaking environment and demonstrably working in English
- Passing a [Duolingo test](#)
